- ❖ Modality
 - ✚ Upon registration, you will receive the course schedule and guide details.
 - ✚ Course materials will be provided on scheduled dates, allowing you to begin learning.
 - ✚ The guide will send a detailed orientation email to begin the learning process.
 - ✚ After the initial email orientation, you will continue learning through the provided materials. If you encounter difficulties or need further clarification, you can reach out to the guide via email for assistance.
