Course Duration –	Customizable Online 12–30 Module (as per learners' choice) Highly Interactive

C.S_03	Classroom Observation Techniques - ABC charts, anecdotal records, participation, peer interactions.
C.S_04	Behavioural Assessment in School Settings - Functional Behaviour Assessment (FBA) – UG theory → PG practice.
C.S_05	Academic Screening & Learning Difficulty Identification - Basic screening tools, error analysis in reading/writing/math.
C.S_06	Emotional & Behavioural Concerns in School-Age Children - Anxiety, aggression, withdrawal—identification & support strategies.
C.S_07	Designing Individualized Support Plans (ISP) - Academic, behavioural, emotional support planning.
C.S_08	Psychoeducation for Students, Teachers & Parents - Creating content, checklists, sessions, handouts.
C.S_09	Working With Teachers & Creating Classroom Strategies - Collaborative problem-solving and behaviour management planning.
C.S_10	Crisis Management in Schools - Handling breakdowns, panic, conflict, safety procedures.
C.S_11	Documentation, Reporting & Case Notes - Professional templates, progress monitoring, ethical writing.
C.S_12	Ethics & Professional Boundaries in School Settings - Consent, child protection, confidentiality, multidisciplinary work.
