Course Duration –	Customizable Online 12–30 Module (as per learners' choice) Highly Interactive

C.S_01	Role of a Child Psychologist in Applied Settings - Clinical, school, community roles; boundaries; ethical limitations.
C.S_02	Child Intake Interviewing (Parents + Child) - Rapport building, development history, structured child-friendly questions.
C.S_03	Developmental & Behavioural Observation Skills - Play observation, ABC analysis, naturalistic vs structured observation.
C.S_04	Screening Children for Developmental & Emotional Concerns - Basic milestone checklists (interpretation basics).
C.S_05	Identifying Emotional & Behavioural Issues in Children - Anxiety, aggression, social withdrawal, impulsivity—case-based recognition.
C.S_06	Assessing Learning Concerns in Children - Reading/writing/math errors, processing difficulties, early LD indicators.
C.S_07	Creating Behaviour Support Plans (BSP) - Antecedents, consequences, reinforcement schedules, practical planning.
C.S_08	Play-Based Assessment Techniques - Symbolic play, projective play, toys selection, observation notes.
C.S_09	Parent Guidance & Counselling for Child Concerns - Explaining problems, giving strategies, managing resistance.
C.S_10	Designing Child-Friendly Psychoeducation Modules - Emotions, social skills, coping skills—scripts and worksheets.
C.S_11	Case Documentation & Progress Review - Session notes, behaviour trackers, progress monitoring templates.

C.S_12	Child Safety, Ethics & Mandatory Reporting - Child protection, boundaries, consent/assent, reporting protocols.

O.S_13	Working With Children with Anxiety & Fearfulness - Exposure hierarchy (child-friendly), grounding tools, coping charts.
O.S_14	Anger & Aggression Management in Children - Triggers mapping, regulation tools, modelling, reinforcement.
O.S_15	ADHD Case Handling in Practical Settings - Focus routines, visual schedules, collaboration with teachers/parents.
O.S_16	Autism Support Strategies - Sensory needs, communication supports, routines, meltdown management.
O.S_17	Emotional Regulation Programs for Children - Zones of regulation, breathing sets, emotion vocabulary training.
O.S_18	Social Skills Training Group (SST) for Children - Turn-taking, conversation skills, sharing, roleplay activities.
O.S_19	Supporting Children Facing Trauma or Loss - Grief responses, safety plans, grounding, emotional expression through play/drawing.
O.S_20	Managing School Refusal & Separation Anxiety - Behavioural shaping, attendance ladders, parent collaboration.
O.S_21	Working With Adolescents: Risk, Identity, Behaviour - Peer issues, self-esteem, online exposure, mood concerns.
O.S_22	Assessing Family Dynamics in Child Cases - Parenting styles, communication patterns, home routines.
O.S_23	Designing Individualized Intervention Plans (IIP) - Stepwise goals, behavioural and academic targets, monitoring.
O.S_24	Classroom Management Strategies (Psychology Perspective) - Transitions, reinforcement, clear expectations.
O.S_25	Sensory Processing Issues in Children - Indicators, sensory diet basics (safe-level), classroom accommodations.
O.S_26	Cognitive Skills Enhancement Activities - Attention training, memory tasks, basic cognitive remediation.
O.S_27	Child Group Interventions & Workshops - Self-esteem, study skills, emotional wellbeing.
O.S_28	Working With Children with Special Needs - Inclusive practices, collaboration with special educators.
O.S_29	Case Conference Presentation Skills - Sharing findings with teachers and parents professionally.
