Course Duration –	Customizable Online 12–30 Module (as per learners' choice) Highly Interactive
Course Mode –	Online fixed scheduled interactive sessions with supporting learning materials
Course Structure –	12–30 Modules – Fully Customizable – Trainer-Led Sessions – Daily / Weekly

C.S_02	Conducting a Couple Intake Interview - Joint session + individual sessions, exploring relationship history, expectations.
C.S_03	Assessing Relationship Dynamics - Patterns, cycles, communication styles, emotional climate.
C.S_04	Identifying Core Conflict Areas - Values, roles, communication patterns, unmet needs.
C.S_05	Working With Communication Patterns - Pursuer–withdrawer dynamics, demand–withdraw patterns.
C.S_06	Emotional Regulation for Couples - Helping partners identify triggers, de-escalation tools.
C.S_07	Attachment Theory Applied in Couple Work - Adult attachment styles, bonding, insecurity patterns.
C.S_08	Building Healthy Communication Skills - Active listening, validation, expressing needs without attack.
C.S_09	Conflict De-escalation Techniques - Time-outs, grounding, slowing the cycle
C.S_10	Case Formulation in Couple Therapy - Understanding relationship patterns using systemic lenses.
C.S_11	Ethical Issues in Couple Work - Confidentiality, secrets, alliance balancing, therapist neutrality.
C.S_12	Termination, Relapse Prevention & Follow-up Planning - Preparing couples for future conflict cycles & maintenance work.

O.S_14	Emotion-Focused Therapy (EFT) for Couples – Applied Basics - Primary/secondary emotions, bonding events, cycle de-escalation.
O.S_15	Behavioural Couple Therapy (BCT) Techniques - Behaviour exchange, couple contracts, positive interactions.
O.S_16	Solutions-Focused Work with Couples - Exception finding, scaling, desired future mapping.
O.S_17	Working With High-Conflict Couples - Anger cycles, blame patterns, de-escalation scripts.
O.S_18	Infidelity & Trust Repair Work - Disclosure handling, rebuilding trust, boundaries.
O.S_19	Intimacy Issues & Emotional Distance - Understanding avoidance, vulnerability work.
O.S_20	Pre-Marital Counselling Modules - Expectations, communication, role negotiation, future planning.
O.S_21	Parenting Stress & Couple Dynamics - Role transition, shared responsibility, conflict triggers.
O.S_22	Financial Conflict & Decision-Making Styles - Money scripts, budgeting conversations.
O.S_23	Cultural & Family Influences on Couple Relationships - Indian family norms, in-laws, joint-family stressors.
O.S_24	Working With Separation or Divorce-Oriented Couples - Clarification process, emotional disentangling, co-parenting dialogues.
O.S_25	Sexual Health & Couple Communication - Consent, comfort, dysfunction psychoeducation (ethically framed).
O.S_26	Substance Use & Its Impact on Couple Functioning - Patterns, codependency, boundaries, referral pathways.
O.S_27	Domestic Violence Screening & Safety Planning - Red flags, risk assessment, ethical referral protocols.
O.S_28	LGBTQIA+ Couples – Inclusive Practice - Affirmative language, family acceptance, identity conflicts
O.S_29	Mixed-Culture or Long-Distance Relationship Challenges - Negotiation, expectations, communication templates.
O.S_30	Designing Couple Workshops - Communication bootcamps, relationship hygiene modules.
O.S_31	Documentation & Couple Case Notes - Writing balanced, non-blaming, systemic notes.
O.S_32	Therapist Self-Management in Couple Work - Dealing with reactivity, neutrality, burnout prevention.
